Guest Policy

January 2026

Below are the rules that have been approved for members bringing guests to the club.

First these rules apply to all Life, Emeritus, Vested, General, or Extended Spousal members.

1. The definition of a guest is:
 - a. Any person over the age of twenty-one (21) as of January 1st of the current year.
 - b. Or, any person, regardless of age, that is not a child, grandchild, sibling, or person under guardianship of the member.
2. The limit set for guests is two (2) on club property not just on a range.
 - a. The card holding member is the only person allowed to have guests. A member's family is NOT allowed to have separate guests.
 - b. This limit is NOT applicable to people shooting at an approved and organized event.
3. The guests are the responsibility of the club member, and the member is accountable for their actions.
4. The member must sign-in at the range building and list the number of guests they have with them before moving to the range.
5. The member must have each guest sign a waiver available in the range building. For guests under the age of eighteen (18) the waiver needs to be signed by a custodial parent or legal guardian.
6. It is required for each guest to pay a \$5.00 daily fee to use the rifle / pistol or archery ranges. This fee is paid into the yellow tube found near the range building or on the shooting line of the archery range.
