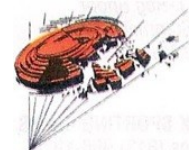
## Public Open Shooting

### Pricing for the various ranges:

- ◆ Trap or skeet shooting is \$11.00 per round of 25 targets (*adult*) and \$7.00 (*youth, under 18*).
- ◆ We sell shotshells with price dependent on brand and availability, or you can bring your own.
  - ◇ Please note we only allow target loads 7-1/2 or smaller, **NO** field or magnum loads.
- ◆ Rifle or pistol will be \$20.00 (*adult*) and \$5.00 (*youth, under 18*) Check-In and Pay in the main clubhouse—straight in front of the main road on the west end of the parking lot when you arrive.
  - ◇ We have ranges out to 200-yards.
  - ◇ You will need your own target stands for the ranges other than the 100 & 200-yard ranges. See below for information on their construction.
  - ◇ We do **NOT** sell any targets or center-fire ammunition, you must bring your own.
- ◆ There will be **NO** refunds once any shots are fired.



### Now for some of the boring but necessary business:

- ◆ Rifle and Pistol shooters **MUST** check-in with the RSO at the range building before moving to any range. There you will be required to sign the login book and a hold-harmless release form.
- ◆ For any minor wishing to shoot, first they must be accompanied by parent with custodial rights or a legal guardian and show proof of completion of a Firearms Safety course.
  - ◇ The parent / guardian of a minor will need to sign the hold-harmless release on their behalf.
- ◆ Everyone on the range property **MUST** obey all our range rules as well as any instructions or commands given by a Range Safety Officer (RSO), there are no exceptions.
- ◆ The consumption of alcohol or use of drugs are NOT allow before or during shooting.
- ◆ We do have some target stands, there is a \$10.00 deposit — refunded for the return of an undamaged stand. It is best to bring your own stand. **Notice:** it must be made of wood or permeable plastic. Any ground support to hold the stand may be made of metal.
- ◆ You must bring your own paper targets and staple gun.
- ◆ All other non-paper targets and target set-ups must be approved by a Club RSO.
- ◆ No holster work — No full-auto firearms — No 50-BMG or cartridges / wildcats based on the 50-BMG case.
- ◆ Any special or out-of-the-ordinary activities will need to be approved by the RSO first.
